Letters to Larry

*Dear Larry,
I would like to use a ChannelPlus modulator to modulate a front door camera to the TV however, the existing camera has a BNC connector. Is it compatible?*

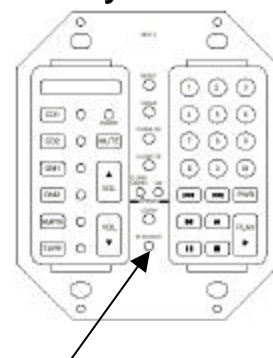
Dear Installer,
The existing camera should work fine with any of our modulators however, you need to modify the connector. I recommend crimping an "F" connector onto the coax and then attaching an RCA adaptor. The RCA connector will then attach to the modulator.

*Dear Larry,
I installed an MDS-6 multi-room music distribution system that worked great until I cloned the MCS-2 keypads. Now, whenever the customer tries to adjust the volume control the system either locks up or goes mute.*

Dear installer,
It sounds like the keypad is corrupted. When you clone an MCS-2 keypad it is necessary to cover the IR sensor on both the teaching keypad and the clones with a piece of black electrical tape (see diagram). When the keypads are placed in the cloning mode, the left

side of the keypad is susceptible to corruption from stray IR commands or IR noise such as florescent lights, etc. If corruption occurs it will cause problems similar to the problems you described. It is then necessary to completely clear the infected controllers to factory condition. This is done by cloning an unprogrammed controller to the corrupted controller. Once this is done, that controller can then be re-cloned.
